

Pensacola Camellia Club Photo Contest 2021 - Entries accepted March 26th - April 10th.

Contest category descriptions and judging criteria.

- 1. Single Flower Display – Named Varieties (1st place and 2nd place awards possible)**
 - a. Photo must include a single flower. The flower may be displayed as if presented in a flower show or the flower may be presented in any artistic display. Avoid reflective or shining surfaces as backdrops.
 - b. Enter Variety Name, Species (Japonica, Reticulata, other), Flower size (miniature, small, medium, large, very large)
 - c. First and second place awards will be given. Named Flowers must conform to the ACS nomenclature descriptions for variety form, color, and size.
- 2. Single Flower Display – Unknown Varieties (1st place and 2nd place awards possible)**
 - a. Photo must include a single flower. The flower may be displayed as if presented in a flower show or the flower may be presented in any other artistic display. Avoid reflective or shining surfaces as backdrops.
 - b. First and second place awards will be given.
- 3. Artistic Floral Display (1 – 1st place and 1 – 2nd place award possible) -multiple flowers**
 - a. Camellia flowers only. Display may include a single variety or multiple varieties. Display may include Camellia foliage, foliage of other plants, or no foliage. But no flowers of other species.
 - b. First and Second place awards will be given for the best Artistic Floral Display Photo category. The photos will be judged based on the Camellia flower condition, artistic display, originality, and overall presentation.
- 4. Landscape Photo (1 – 1st place and 1 – 2nd place award possible)**
 - a. Partial or entire views of Camellia shrubs with flowers in landscapes (includes Camellias in containers). Other plants may be included but the primary subject of the photo must be a flowering camellia.
 - b. First and Second place awards will be given for the Landscape photo Display category.
- 5. Best Photo (1 award)**
 - a. A first place winner from Categories 1-4 will be selected by vote of all judges to receive an award for the Best Pensacola Camellia Club Photo for 2021.

We kindly request photograph entries are limited to flowers from the Winter 2020 - Spring 2021 season
